## LANGUAGE SERVICES ACCESSIBILITIES

The committee shall consist of an Area Language Services Accessibilities Chair, and eight District Languages Services Accessibilities chairs, one from each district. The primary purpose of this service committee is to assist support the efforts of districts, groups and individual AA members endeavoring to insure that those with accessibilities issues have access to the AA message. with their local Language Services Accessibilities activity. The Language Services Accessibilities This Committee is to provide non-English-speaking members the opportunity to participate fully in Area Third Legacy service. This committee, to help overcome the language barrier experienced by non-English-speaking members, will provide translators, translating equipment, and bilingual printed materials as deemed necessary to provide non-English-speaking members the opportunity to participate fully in Area Third Legacy service. This will allow those who would otherwise be unable to serve because of language barriers, to be of service to other Area service committees where language keeps us from reaching all that wish to recover. All translating equipment will be kept at the Area Committee office and used under the supervision of the Language Service Accessibilities Committee.
